

## **PREDICTING PSYCHOSIS: PROMISING RESEARCH IN EARLY IDENTIFICATION, INTERVENTION & PREVENTION**

**Kristin Cadenhead**, Professor of Psychiatry and attending physician, and Director, Cognitive Assessment and Risk Evaluation (CARE) Program, UC San Diego School of Medicine

Dr. Cadenhead will discuss current research aimed at developing a Psychosis Risk Prediction Calculator to better identify individuals at highest risk of developing a psychotic illness. This work includes the development of biomarkers that can be used not only to predict psychosis risk but also to help illuminate the mechanism by which psychosis emerges. Dr. Cadenhead will discuss promising treatments that may help to delay or prevent the development of psychotic illness and improve outcomes.
